## Parent Governor Role

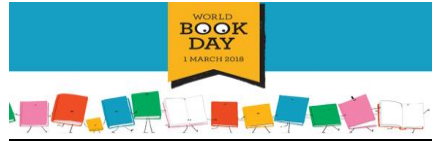
If you would like to nominate yourself as a Parent Governor, the deadline is **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018**.
