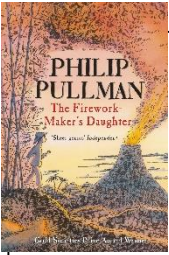


Year 4 Homework Summer Term 1

Mountains, Rivers and Coasts / States of Matter/ The Firework Maker's

English



Write a conversation between two characters from the book *The Firework Maker's Daughter*. **Challenge:** Use *inverted commas and correct speech punctuation*.

Write a set of instructions to tell Lila how to get to the sacred volcano. **Challenge:** Use *fronted adverbials*.

Write a poem about the land through which Lila is traveling. **Challenge:** Include *similes and/or metaphors*.

Write a settings description for *The Firework Maker's Daughter*. What can you see, hear, smell, touch and taste on the journey through the jungle?

Challenge: Include *expanded noun phrases and similes or metaphors*.

Write a character description for one of the characters in *The Firework Maker's Daughter*. **Challenge:** Include *expanded noun phrases and relative clauses*.

Write a list of items that Lila should take on her journey. **Challenge:** Include *commas for lists and modal verbs*.

Write an information page about a famous mountain or river. **Challenge:** Include *headings and subheadings*.

Computing

Create a PowerPoint showing some examples of materials changing state.

Create a collage of the sights that Lila may see on her journey to the sacred volcano.

Generate numbers to practice the method of short division. Divide 2 or 3 digit numbers by a 1-digit number.

Practice adding and subtracting decimal numbers. Perhaps look at prices in a shop or a magazine and practice finding the total using the column methods.

P.E.

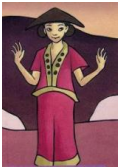
How fast can you run a set distance e.g. 100m? Can you improve your time?

Practice your throwing and catching skills with a partner. How many different passes can you use? Or, how many times can you throw and catch without dropping the ball?

Art/DT

Use pencils, pastels or paints to create a scene from *The Firework Maker's Daughter*.

Sketch and label a new outfit for Lila. Consider her cultural dress.



Use collaging materials to create an image of an elephant.



Science

Write an explanation of the water cycle and include drawings or pictures if you wish.

Create a poster to explain the different states of matter and the arrangement of particles in each.

With an adult, observe how a material changes through either heating or cooling. What happens? Can you time how long it takes to change? What temperature did the material need to be to change?

History and Geography

Research a famous mountaineer and create a fact file about them and their achievements.

Research the weather in the UK in a particular month and compare it to the weather of a country that lies near the Tropic of Cancer or Tropic of Capricorn.

Label some of the rivers and mountains of the UK on a map.
