Vikings / Sound/ How to train your Dragon



English

Write a poem about a dragon of your choice. **Challenge: Include similes and/or metaphors.**

Imagine your own dragon and write a character description. **Challenge: Include expanded noun phrases.**

Write a letter to the prime minister about the problem of plastic pollution and your suggestions to help solve the problem. **Challenge: Include a relative clause.**

Write a dialogue between two characters of your choice from 'How to train your Dragon'. **Challenge: Include inverted commas and speech punctuation.**

Write an information page about different aspects of Viking life. **Challenge: Use subheadings.**

Write a diary entry from the point of view of your favourite character from 'How to train your Dragon'. **Challenge: Include a range of adverbs and conjunctions.**

Write a story about a Viking. **Challenge: Include possessive apostrophes and apostrophes for contractions.**

Create a glossary of words using a dictionary to help you. Your words should link to one of our topics; Vikings or Sound.

Computing

Create a collage of Swedish culture; music, food, important people, sports etc.

Use PowerPoint or Word to create a short fact file about a famous Scientist who contributed to our understanding of sound.

You must complete **one piece of work** every week and hand it in on the following **Wednesday.**

You can find information books for Science, History and Geography in the local libraries or the school library as well as information online.

Read at least once a day at home.

Keep practicing all of the times tables up to 12 x 12.

Practice your spellings for our spelling tests on Fridays.

Maths

Using your knowledge of acute, obtuse and right angles, find examples of each around your home.

Use dice or generate a number with one decimal place and practice rounding to the nearest whole number.

Ask your friends and family for their favourite animal/ book/ musical instrument etc. and create a bar graph to show the results.

P.E.

Practice your jumping skills. What is the longest distance you can jump? Which type of jump helps you to travel the furthest distance?

With a friend or family member, practice your bowling and/or batting skills. Can you see your skills improving over time?

Art/DT

Design (and/ or make) a Viking longboat.

Design and sketch your own dragon. Label it with its different features and abilities.

Linking to our Eco Week: Make a sea creature of your choice using used plastic from around the home - check before you use it! It can be added to our classroom display.

Science

Write a short explanation or draw a diagram to explain how sound travels to the ear.

Use junk modelling equipment to create your own musical instrument.

Survey your home for sounds. What different sounds can you hear? Can you identify the loudest and quietest rooms? Could you draw a simple map to show your findings?

History and Geography

Linking to our World Cup Week: Research a city of Sweden and create a fact file about it.

Research a famous or influential person from Sweden and write a short explanation of their work.

Plan a journey to Sweden. How long would it take? What modes of transport would need to be used?
